Perfect for the insomniacs among us looking to get-on-the-air. Be sure to contact us on our 146.290 (110.9) repeater so that we can open the park gate for you.**

**We have an IC-7600 and 2 Yaesu FT-1000s, 2 towers, 1 SteppIR beam, 2 Fan Dipoles, a full length 80m Vertical and an end-fed 160m as well as other Ham amenities. Bring your own keyer/paddle and/or head set, if you like. Advance special arrangements for personal radio equipment need to be made in advance!**

**We recommend qualifying on our equipment at our shack Saturday or Wednesday morning prior to 2:00 PM EDT Field Day when the FD madness begins and all-heck-breaks-loose. Get the most out of the experience by qualifying/requalifying beforehand and not during Field Day when you could be making contacts!**
